ISSUES DISCUSSED

1. Lighting - It is evident that the need for extra lighting is needed all around and along the path from Haspalls Road to Southlands.

2. CCTV – This was highlighted as a possible requirement for security.

3. Toilets – The toilet area or possible changing room facilities could be sited in the centre of the Recreation Field on the Haspalls Road side.

4. Furniture - Dog bins on every entrance. More seating needed especially around play areas. More litter bins required – possible relocation of town centre bins recreation field. A staggered gate system was discussed for the all the entrances.

5. Fencing/Hedging – Low level hedging all around, this will help to reduce pollution, noise etc. To contact Norfolk County Council and Breckland Council to be placed on the tree list – Grants possible.

6. Signs – There are not any poop scoop signs or no cycling signs. Possibility of Dogs on Leads signs but there must be plenty of bins.

7. The flowerbed near the toilets, does it need to be there?

8. Other ideas - Adventure trail – idea from a youngster on the Recreation Field. Nature trail or trim trail all the way around the Recreation Field. The path area around the Recreation Field could be fenced off creating a dog walking area.
